- Race starts and finishes at **PINELANDS ATHLETIC CLUB**, Lower Oval, Pinelands.
- A safe tog bag facility will be provided at runners own risk.
- Entry fee for licenced runners is **R120.00**. Ages 70+ **R70.00**. Juniors is **R80.00**. Fun Run (5km) is **R50.00**. Temporary licence fees are **R60.00** for Seniors and **R40.00** for Juniors.
- Fun Run:** Participants younger than 10 years must be accompanied by an adult.
- Social Walkers are welcome to enter the 10km run. Walkers to start at the back and to keep to the side of the road.
- Results will be available on www.wpa.org.za.

RACE RULES: 10km Run

- The race is run according to the rules of ASA & WPA.
- Runners must obey traffic officers, race marshals and race officials at all times.
- Participants must be 14 years of age or older on race day.
- No personal seconding permitted except at official refreshment stations.
- The time limit is **120 minutes**. Cut off 09h30.
- Licensed runners should run in club colours and licences valid for 2026 must be worn on the front and back of the vest or purchase a temporary licence to be worn on the front of the vest. Temporary licences will be available at registration. When registering, participants must complete and hand in the tear-off strip from the number in order to be eligible to compete.
- Team prizes: Only South African citizens are eligible and must wear full club colours and run with a permanent licence number.
- Temporary licensed runners to wear plain clothing, no advertising.
- Age category tags must be worn (front & back) and be visible for the entire race to be eligible for any age category prizes including Juniors.
- No race numbers will be issued.
- The use of music players with headphones is not allowed and may result in disqualification.
- Entry cards must be carried throughout the race and handed in at the finish.
- Do not litter. Dispose of cups responsibly by using the boxes provided or carrying them to the finish. Report offenders to the referees. #RunClean
- Coke will be available at the finish.
- Entrants participate at their own risk.
- Prize giving will be soon after 09h30.

PRIZES

- In addition to Overall (Open) prizes, participants will only be eligible for an age category prize in the age category they enter. Corresponding numerical age category tags must be worn on the front and back of their vest. Participants may enter the age category corresponding to their chronological age or any younger category down to senior.
- Temporary licensed participants are eligible for age category prizes provided they enter the relevant age group, wear the appropriate age tags and provide proof of age.
- Juniors born 2007 or later, must display age tags "J" to qualify for age group prizes. Juniors will count towards Open team prizes.
- Licences valid for 2026 must be worn front and back of vest and club colours must be worn to qualify for team prizes.
